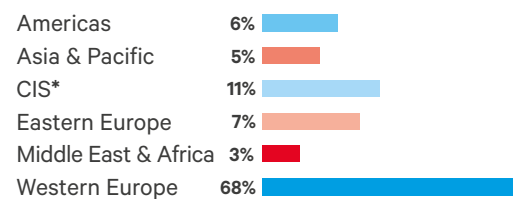
Where Nature Meets Culture
